MORE FROM THE SCRIBE Canton

The club came into existence in 1876 and for much of its history was a prominent force in Cardiff and District rugby, winning the Mallett Cup seven times.

Records indicate Canton Rovers RFC as an early forerunner in the history of Canton RFC and that the suburb of Canton was a hotbed of rugby teams with the Wanderers, Crescents, Wednesday, United, Harlequins, Crusaders, Institute, Albions, Raglans, Wesleyans, Villa, Canton Loco, Canton Parish Church & Canton St Mary's all playing for the most part in the C&DRU leagues.

In recent years, having originally played near St John's Church and based themselves at the Boar's Head, Canton have established an impressive new HQ at Lawrenny Road in Leckwith.

Many latter-day Canton players have gone on to gain first class honours including Glen Webbe, Mike Knill, Wayne Lewis and John Hickey The club won the East Central B by a considerable distance a few years ago. This season has been mixed but they've had some decent performances since the turn of the year. We inflicted a heavy 41-17 defeat on them in early April, but some wins subsequently and an agonisingly close one-point reverse at the hands of leaders Penarth suggest that today's game is anything but a formality for us.

However, depending on happenings here and in Pentyrch (v Penarth) we could be champions by tea time – that would be worthy icing on the promotion cake for Scott and the boys as well as the holy coaching triumvirate of Gareth, Andy and Kev.

THE SCRIBE LOOKS BACK TEN YEARS

SWALEC NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP March 15 BRIDGEND ATH 12 LLANHARAN 13 (HT 12-10)

Ryan Evans was the hero for Llanharan in this Friday night game, dropping the match winning goal with the very last kick of the game, his second such score of

the night.

The outside half from Tonyrefail, who joined the club from Pontypridd this year, has taken over the number ten shirt left vacant by Codey Rees's injury, and he took his chance with an aplomb that his stricken colleague would have been proud of.

On a night of incessant heavy rain, the result really developed from an amazing

lost chance to seal the game by the Athletic.

Ten minutes from time their number eight Sean Derrick made a searing break from a scrum forty metres out. Covering ground at speed and wrong footing Llanharan's last man with ease, he seemed on his way to the posts but went to ground just short and lost possession in a frantic attempt to scramble over the line.

Llanharan won the scrum and then three consecutive penalties from referee Tom

Williams put us into Athletic territory.

The pack kept grinding away, but ball retention was difficult in the rain. However, we were awarded a scrum twenty five metres out, Nathan Huish's pack ensured good possession, and replacement scrum half Tom James spun it back to Evans waiting in the pocket.

It was never going to be an easy kick, but the man more at home in the centre and suffering from tonsillitis, made it look easy work as it dropped just over the

bar leaving the home team stunned.

Head coach Matthew Lloyd said: "It was a hard-fought match that was always going to be very close and the Athletic played a well-controlled game, living off our mistakes and at times looking very dangerous with the ball in hand. We didn't get into our stride and there was little continuity in our play".

Added backs coach Adam Rosser: "It was difficult to play and was a local derby – one score was always going to be enough to separate the teams and full marks

to our boys for their endeavour right to the end."
