MORE FROM THE SCRIBE COWBRIDGE

It is surprisingly difficult to find any history details on the club – in fact I found out more on the local 19th century version of 'Eton fives' whose surviving courts I played in as a grammar school pupil in the town. The school itself was one of the first recorded locations for the playing of organised rugby union. In the 1870s the 'boys' XV were one of the first opponents for Cardiff RFC. The town certainly has a long sporting tradition – the cricket club dates to 1840!

So, to present times - Cowbridge experienced a mixed bag of a season 2022/23 and couldn't lower the colours of the Cynon valley's promoted trio. Nevertheless, some notable victories and a respectable 6th place with 11 wins and 11 defeats, scoring 429 pints with 64 tries in the process.

In the previous COVID hit incomplete competition they were sitting 2^{nd} when it terminated, with an impressive 9 wins from 11 games.

23/24 Opened with narrow defeat at Llanishen but victories followed including v Gilfach, where Charlie Locke scored 40 seconds try, and at Llantwit Fardre.

It's subsequently been a varied campaign with some good wins alongside close defeats – including that 22-20 reverse against us back in January. So, a side to be respected.

Our coaches and players have given us another memorable season, last week's cup win the latest impressive result, but for today it's all about league points as we look to enhance our place in the rugby hierarchy. Cowbridge, fresh from last week's win at Treharris, will go all out to deny our ambitions, and we will need to be at our best.

THE SCRIBE LOOKS BACK

And the Scribe looks back on ten seasons ago:

SWALEC NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Oct 12 2013 TATA STEEL 27 LLANHARAN 34 (HT 8-18)

24-year-old outside half Codey Rees spent 2011/12 at the Margam Sports Ground and returned to one of his old stamping grounds with a vengeance, his deadly boot supplying nineteen points to help the team to victory and move us into third place in the Championship.

This was a hard-fought victory for us and we had to dig in defensively on several occasions as we allowed Tata to grab the four tries that always kept them in the game.

Said head coach Matthew Lloyd: "A good performance. But as a team we still have a lot of work to do. However, the boys showed great commitment and will gain confidence from this victory against a very good Tata side, but we must improve defensively. The players are enjoying themselves and along with my fellow coaches Adam Rosser and Colin Malone I am pleased with the way the squad is gelling and the boys are playing for each other." 




