MORE FROM THE SCRIBE

Fairwater



From the west of Cardiff, Fairwater RFC were first formed in 1966-67, their headquarters the Bulldog Public House. They won the Mallett Cup in 1973-74, taking the scalp of Llandaff 3-0. The following season they lost to the CIACS 19-0 but sadly, with players moving from the area, the side disbanded in 1984. In 1988, club stalwart Phil Regan returned after a spell abroad and dismayed by that setback he successfully started the move to get the club playing again, the Bulldog once more the centre of activity. His faith was rewarded in 1991, the club taking the Welsh Brewers Cup, beating the CIACS 13-3 and not conceding a try through the whole of the competition. In 1992 they lost the final to St Alban's 21-20 and in 1995 they lost another final to Banwen 16-11, but in 2000 Theaker's team triumphed over Nant Conwy 16-6. Official recognition of such achievements came with WRU status that year. Success continued - in 2002 they won Seven East, in 2003 were runners-up in Six East, and in 2005 they won Four East. The current campaign has been a mixed bag. Since losing at home to us in early January results have been 50/50. There was a narrow defeat to St Albans last weekend, but they still sit comfortably in the upper half of the table so a tough game awaits us.

CONGRATULATIONS

In addition to my normal contributions, I must add me heartfelt congratulations to Scott and the squad on achieving promotion, with a championship still a prospect. Nurtured by the complementary skills of Gareth and Andy, they have produced thrilling rugby, skilful and fast. When we were in free fall a few years back I heard to my dismay the phrase 'we'll find our own level'. After sixty unbroken years at the club, I think I can knowledgeably say that our level is to be found upwards, not downwards. We're on our way!

We dispelled the air of disappointment attendant on an unexpected run of defeats with a brilliant five tries bonus point victory at Newbridge. It was Gwent revenge as just days earlier we had suffered a 6th successive reverse as champions Ebbw Vale inflicted a record Dairyfield score against us. And it looked like we were going to be in for another long, hard eighty minutes as a lively Welfare Ground side took a 14-0 lead. But the boys soon got their act together in defence and attack to silence the vociferous element in the home team's crowd, even scoring without reply in a yellow card period.
