MORE FROM THE SCRIBE LAMPETER

One of the enjoyable features of WRU cup games is it brings you into contact with new opponents, and today is no different as we entertain our Division Three West guests Lampeter.

To give it its full name, Lampeter Town Rugby Football Club is a member of the Welsh Rugby Union and is a feeder club for the Llanelli Scarlets. It is a well-established club fielding 15 teams, including a Ladies and Youth XV

The 1st XV are currently having a good season, sitting on top of Three West A after that 74 -17 thrashing of Cardigan last weekend. Last month they suffered a narrow 18-17 defeat against promotion rivals Aberaeron but followed that setback with some big wins. Their league points tally reads F509 A93 with over 70 tries in 10 games, a record which speaks for itself.

Of course, they beat our neighbours Pontyclun in the last round of the cup. In the qualifying rounds they squeezed out Aberavon Green Stars by virtue of a 12-11 superior try count!

Lampeter is believed to be the first town in Wales to field a rugby union team when in 1850 the Reverend Professor Rowland Williams brought the game with him from Cambridge to St. David's College, Lampeter. Although no evidence exists of the origination of Lampeter RFC as a separate club team from Lampeter College there is written proof of a match in the *Western Mail* between the college team and a Lampeter club in 1879. In 1881 the *Carmarthen Journal* reported representatives from Lampeter were present at the formation of the Welsh Rugby Union.. They play in maroon shirts, their nickname appropriately 'The Maroons', and are based at North Road in the historic academic town. The official formation of the current club is cited as 1875.



THE SCRIBE LOOKS BACK

Issues of space prevented this look-back from appearing in the Pentyrch programme, so here it is today on another cup occasion.

"The boys are growing up fast", was head coach Matthew Lloyd's tribute to our young team as we collected a third consecutive bonus point win.

His comment reflected the way we'd dealt with difficult playing conditions and

opponents whose play belied their bottom placed position.

It meant that it was far from a one-way process and Llanharan dominated in patches, only to see the west Walians play catch up whenever the contest seemed a foregone conclusion.

It looked as though Llan had made the game safe when the bonus point fourth try arrived. Effective number eight James Locke made a surging run through the middle, timing his offload to perfection for Evans to finish off, Thomson's kick stretching the gap to 24-12.

However, Whitland were far from dead and buried. They had shown commendable willingness to play football throughout, but went back to basics as they put a penalty out on the five metres line and hooker Mark Jones rounded off

the driving maul.

Thomas converted and there was every prospect of an upset, but the indomitable Thomson, making a good job of wearing Rees's ten shirt, ran strongly to create a penalty opportunity, his own successful kick the last of the match and one that deprived a gallant Whitland team of even a consolation bonus point.

Forwards coach Colin Malone, a stalwart of our pack for many years, was pleased that the side had won the second half 15-7 into the gale, praising the heart amongst the players and their desire to win.

A big effort had been demanded in the half time dressing room, and it had been

delivered.
