MORE FROM THE SCRIBE

Our friends and neighbours from just up the road came into being in 1888. However, Llantrisant disbanded after World War two and we were one of the proposers who helped get them readmitted to the WRU in 1982. For many years our change strip was black and it is said it came from our purchase of their jerseys when they went out of business. I recall in those far off days changing at the back of the Wheatsheaf and trudging up the main road to Cefn Mably, that infamous slope and, always, a reception of fire on the field – with Cefn Mabley clubhouse and changing facilities today's players would find it hard to get their head around that one.

'Black Army', of course, the nickname relating to the fact that the longbowmen of Llantrisant sided victoriously with Edward, the Black Prince, at the Battle of Crecy.

The club badge is a representation of the Seal of the Llantrisant Town Trust, representing the arms of the Consul, De Clare and Despenser families who had historical connections with the ancient town.

Honours came their way in the later 20th century - Brewers Cup 1981-82, and Glamorgan County Silver Ball Trophy 1988-89 and 1993-94. The WRU Division Two East Championship was won in 2006-07.

This season has been another tough one for this proud club, losing all their games to date. Last year they missed relegation comfortably, but won just five of 22 games. To their credit they have managed to fulfil all fixtures despite struggling for a team some weeks.

Saturday saw us complete a splendid record-breaking treble. So, what's left? Well, to complete a 100% season would be something this club has never achieved, though I am sure Llantrisant will want to end on a high and spoil the party.

Whatever, we have been treated to an exhilarating campaign of high speed and skilful attacking rugby – some of the best I have seen in my 60 years at the club. Well done, and thank you!

THE SCRIBE LOOKS BACK TEN YEARS

SWALEC NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP 2013/14 Nov 23 LLANHARAN 19 BONYMAEN 22 (HT 14-17)

With two tries and fourteen points on the board inside ten minutes against bottom club Bonymaen, we could be forgiven for indulging in try bonus chat.

Yet quarter of an hour later the Swansea side had shaken of their hapless start to lead 17-14 and look anything like strugglers.

They conceded the lead again in the wake of James Bija's yellow carding but rattled us with a winner just minutes from the end, and we had only a losing bonus point as consolation.

It was only Bonymaen's second success of the campaign.

However, Nathan Huish's side were not helped by a remarkable catalogue of injuries.

Forwards Callum Thomas (broken arm) and prop Simon Collins (shoulder ligaments) had both left the field in that opening fifteen minutes, and before the end fullback Richard Lovering had become the team's second dislocated collar bone in successive games after Scott Malone's misfortune at Bargoed.

Huish and his men made a desperate effort to save the game, declining several kicks at goal which could have earned a draw in search of a winning try, but it was not to be.




