MORE FROM THE SCRIBE PENARTH

Penarth RFC was founded in 1880, originally known as the Batchelor XV, two brothers of this famous family acting as captains in the opening years. They were amalgamated with Penarth Dreadnoughts in 1882 and renamed as Penarth Football Club. Locally the team became known as the "Donkey Island Butcher Boys", a nickname that occasionally remains to this day, along with the more familiar "Seasiders".

Until a steady slow decline in the club's fortunes after a major reorganisation of Welsh rugby, Penarth RFC continued to be a regular force in the "Welsh First Class Clubs", playing their weekly matches against top quality sides.

The highlight of the club's year was the traditional Good Friday hosting of the world-famous Barbarians, who saw the town as their spiritual home, and used the now demolished seafront Esplanade hotel as their base. This fixture marked the start of the "Baa-Baas" annual South Wales Easter tour, but was last played in 1986. It is an achievement that Penarth totted up no fewer than 11 wins against their star-studded opponents over the years.

In my earlier days with our club, we had several significant playing links – for example, Colin Coles in the backs, and Ray Taylor, a skipper and coach to be, in the back row. And, of course, former coach Dennis John was another to don their shirt. We seem to be familiar foes of our friends from the coast over the last few campaigns. They've been having a successful time of it like ourselves. Last year they were promoted runners up to our boys, when we inflicted their only three defeats on them (cup semifinal as well as league double), and the previous campaign Penarth enjoyed another good season, just one defeat courtesy of our boys and, of course, promoted with our championship winning side. So, we've had the better of them over these recent years – but they are a good side and have started 2024/25 with two big wins. We however must put last weekend out of mind – Abercynon themselves said the score in no way reflected the game. But only our best will do today.

And guess who we play in the cup next week? You've got it – the Seasiders!

SWALEC NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Sep 27 2014 BARGOED 42 LLANHARAN 12 (HT 15-9))

Pre match statistics suggested there was only going to be one winner in this top v bottom clash, and so it turned out with Bargoed eventually totting up six tries to maintain their 100% record and leave us pointless.

However, it was a score line that perhaps did little to reflect our input, unstinting efforts throughout eventually nullified by Bargoed's ability to exploit chances to the full.

It might also have been different if both Nathan Huish and Bentley Halpin had not been the latest to fall victim to the prominent soccer goal line marking and dived over for "tries" that could have given their team a half team lead.

The Dairymen went into the game with six changes in the back division where youth product Dan Smith and outside half James Whittingham, who switched from centre, came through with credit.

Indeed, after conceding just a Josh Prosser penalty in the face of strong early pressure, Scott Malone's men proceeded to give as good as they got, Whittingham banging over two kicks for a 6-3 lead.

But the championship leaders struck with two tries in the ten minutes before the changeover as a collapsed scrum brought a penalty try, Prosser converting, and Lewis Prothero punished a blind side gap to make the score 15-6. Despite our efforts the eventual champions were lethal with the line in sight and four more second half tries ended our threat.

Coach Colin Malone felt that despite the result, the side had made Bargoed work hard for victory after again having selection problems through injuries and unavailability.

"We were committed and in contention for much of the game," he said.

Perspective was given by the fact that Llan's four defeats had been against sides in the championship top five.


