MORE FROM THE SCRIBE TAFFS WELL

The club first saw action in the 1880s, and since the early 21st century has been based at the impressive Maes Gwyn complex following the destruction by fire of the original club house.

In the 50s and 60s the famous eight Williams brothers all played for Taff's Well and Cardiff and were very gifted players, the most famous of them being Gareth Edward's childhood hero - Bleddyn Wiliams MBE the 'Prince of Centres', to whom a road in Taff's Well has been dedicated – Ffordd Bleddyn (Bleddyn Way).

The 1970s were a great era for the team with exciting cup runs seeing narrow defeats to star studded Swansea and Llanelli.

The club epitomised the wonderful spirit in so many of the clubs of the time. It was Taff's Well who were to re-define the meaning and context of the phrase 'going north'. As Wales were to take on Scotland at Murrayfield in 1979, it was decided that a representative party would be sent to savour the Scottish hospitality, coming up with the idea of creating a 'Taff's Well Rugby Club on Wheels', which basically consisted of a large HGV lorry supplied by village sponsors Rhys Davies Transport!

As Dave Beese recounts in his club web site notes: 'The mobile 'clubhouse' consisted of sofas, arm-chairs, a bar, piano (complete with travelling troubadour pianist), a 'toilet', decorations and a stock of anti-claustrophobia medications. Against a background of the national lorry drivers strike, the trip made national headlines as the Rhys Davies lorry was one of the very few lorries on the road at that time. The scars of that fateful trip are evident today as many of the people who took the trip have recurring nightmares and find it difficult to sleep without the light on. As a result of the excursion, there are those who believe that the Road Traffic Act was revised through parliament to stop such lunacy ever occurring again.'

Those were the days!

More recently there was bowl final defeat in 2015/16, losing 20-18 to a late score by Burry Port. The last few years have seen a struggle to find wins, but as with all once great clubs a revival will surely come.

THE SCRIBE LOOKS BACK

SWALEC NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP Feb 22 2014 NEWBRIDGE 10 LLANHARAN 13 (HT 10-13)

We put in an afternoon of honest graft to record the double over Gwent rivals Newbridge.

It was a vital win that brought an end to a run of six league defeats and consolidated our mid table status.

Early season form had created a points cushion for us above the danger zone, but an injury hit spell contributed to repeated set backs on the field. There was also no doubt that the young side being developed did not relish the mud and rain that had afflicted fixtures in previous months, and while their Welfare Field looked the worse for wear it actually held up well and was a firm surface.

But most vital for our side was a clear resolve not to be beaten. Forwards coach Colin Malone said at half time they had asked the team to show what they were made of and not sacrifice an albeit narrow 13-10 lead. We responded well leaving Newbridge with just a losing bonus point. Outside half Codey Rees scored all our points, including a try, but suffered mixed fortunes as he departed for hospital in the final minutes with damaged knuckles.

Head coach Matthew Lloyd said he was pleased the way the boys stuck at it after a few weeks without a game and felt that with a little more composure they could have had a couple more tries.






