# MORE FROM THE SCRIBE TREHARIS

The town of Treharris was formed around Harris's Deep Navigation Colliery, which begun coal mining excavations in 1878. The colliery and village were named after the Harris Navigation Steam Coal Company. The club is a classic example of the sort of development that emerged in most of our valley coal mining communities – the club's main pitch today is the site of the old pit pond. They also have access to the Centre of Sporting Excellence in Ystrad Mynach should their field be unplayable.

The current Treharris Phoenix rose out of the ashes in 2009 following the disbanding of the original club in the hard years precipitated by the miners' strike. And its activities have expanded to embrace a mini and juniors section.

Prior to the pandemic Treharris were in the promotion places but have struggled to regain such prominence since, and are currently languishing just above the relegation places. So, despite the impressive performances by our team, we will need to give them respect as they strive to secure their status.




